Main Volunteer Needs:

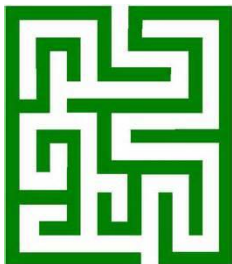
- * Picture day assistant
