- Open House in February

- Qtr ends soon; good week back after break (1/2 year gone!)
- Parent nite on Jan. 24th with science fair
- No teacher needs at present
- 3rd-4th grade class: 8 kids: total 6 chrome books (4 chrome books donated to classroom from man who helped install door security system): doing spelling city; finish work, can use chrome books good incentive
 - o Mrs Hash getting info so class can send thank you
 - o After spring break, use Google docs for writing assignments (Next year: ideal to have one chrome book per student in that class- Technology fund a need)

Treasurer Report:

- Summary of total expenditures to date since Sept: 11,026.36; Total deposits: \$2157.08
Total Balance: \$85, 992.75
- Deposits: Midland fundraising (around \$1300), credit from MicroLynx, Box Tops, etc..
- Book Fair enabled teachers to buy books for classes and credit to purchase items like book shelves (still \$150 credit to spend)
- Fence will probably be another \$2000 w/ concrete
